- Tuition & Fees: **\$6,288**
- Food & Housing: \$6,233 (at home) – **\$9,639** (away from home)
- Personal Expenses: **\$2,988**
- Books & Supplies: **\$1,000**
- Transportation: **\$1,680**
- Loan Fees: \$64+

- **\$18,253** (living at home)

The Professional Women in Building (PWB) Scholarship helps students entering the trades reduce these expenses, making education more accessible and careers in construction more achievable.



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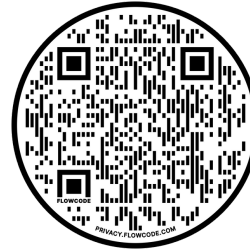
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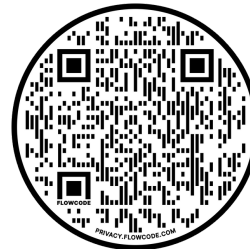
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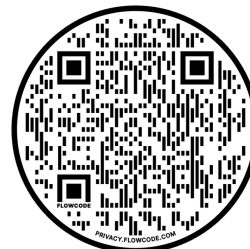
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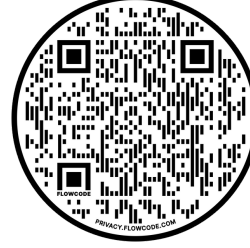
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
